

## Facts about Hovet

Opened in 1955, covered in 1962, refurbished and totally refitted in 2002, with an audience capacity of 8,300. A temple to ice hockey, but with huge scope for corporate events, concerts and receptions of all kinds.

### CAPACITY

- Ice hockey 8,300 pax.
- Concert with stage at west/east, 8,000 pax standing.
- Concert with stage in centre, 9,000 pax standing.
- Banquet and party configuration 1,400 pax.
- Hovets Hylla 1,200 pax standing.
- Hovets Hylla banquet and party configuration 260 pax.

### ARENA FLOOR

- The concrete floor is permanently marked with the outline of an ice hockey rink. The floor is layered with ice from August to April. Normal ice hockey rink 30 x 60 m.

### FITTINGS

- The floor is covered with different flooring for different events.

### CEILING HEIGHT IN HOVET

- To gantry 15.5 m.
- To flying cables 17 m.
- To match clock 11.8 m.
- Foyers have highly varied ceiling height from 2.15 m upwards.

### LOADING

- Entrance from Globen Gate, Arenavägen 35.
- Space for one 18 m trailer or two trucks.
- Offloading via a 30 m walkway, 3 m wide, slightly sloping towards the arena.
- Access door into the arena from the walkway, height 2.90 m, width 3.40 m.
- Offloading to foyers via Globentorget loading bay no. 18, height 2.40 m, width 2.30 m.

### SUSPENSION CAPACITY

- Rigging hung from upper flying cables. Distance between cables is 5.2 m. Max 1,000 kg point load, as instructed. Max 7 tonnes total load per flying cable. Snow on the roof may reduce the max permitted load.

### PLANT

- One forklift truck 1.6 tonnes.
- Three forklift trucks 1.8 tonnes.
- One forklift truck 3.0 tonnes.
- One hydraulic platform (Niftylift) 9.5 m working height.
- Two scissor lifts, one 11.5 m working height and one 6 m working height.

Operators of the above machinery must have a training certificate issued by the Globe Arenas. Contact Hans Svensson/the Globe Arenas for more information.

### PRODUCTION AREAS

- Six changing rooms with shower and toilet.
- One production office.
- One dressing room with shower and toilet.
- Plus three other rooms.

### EVENT CONSTRUCTION

- All constructions, fittings and other material can be arranged/hired through the arena. Fittings list and prices available on request.

### SOUND

- Sound system for sports events (JBL speakers, Crown amplifiers)
- Other equipment can be hired as required.

### LIGHTING

- The ice hockey lighting can be controlled section by section. The event lighting comprises 200 PAR 64 lamps controlled from a central light controller (Compulite).
- Other equipment can be hired as required.



### LSVD (LARGE SCREEN VIDEO DISPLAY)

- A 20 m<sup>2</sup> video screen hangs above the west side of Hovet during the ice hockey season.

### TV PRODUCTION

- It is possible to use the Globe's fixed TV technology.
- There is space for OB trucks between Hovet and Söderstadion.
- Other equipment can be hired as required.

### ELECTRICITY

- 1x 400A 400/230 V 3-phase supply.
- 2x 250A 400/230 V 3-phase supply.
- These sockets are located in the north-west corner of the arena.

### IT

- Telia Homerun (wireless broadband) is available inside the arena. The changing rooms & dressing rooms have fixed internet lines. Fixed internet lines can also be run into the arena on request.

### **CLEANING**

- Cleaning is taken care of by contractors.

### **SAFETY**

- All pyrotechnics must be approved by the police and fire service.
- All constructions must be approved by the arena's head of safety.

### **SECURITY / STAFFING**

- External security is dealt with by a contracted security company.
- Internal security is handled by the arena's event and fire stewards.
- Other security can be arranged through the arena.

### **HEALTHCARE**

- Nurses and doctors can be arranged via the arena.

### **CLOAKROOM**

- The cloakroom service at public events is handled by the arena's contractors.
- A cloakroom service for private events can be arranged via the arena.

### **TICKET SALES**

Tickets for public events are sold via.

### **MASS MEDIA SERVICE**

- Areas for the mass media can be arranged at Hovet on request.

### **PARKING**

- 2,100 parking spaces nearby.
- Free parking for 2 hours in the Globen City car park.

### **PUBLIC ENTRANCES**

- There are two public entrances, one separate entrance for disabled and two VIP entrances for public events.
- Other entrances may be used for private events.

### **CATERING**

All serving of food, drink, confectionery etc is handled by contractors. There are six kiosks and two restaurant areas in Hovet's public areas.

### **HOSPITALITY ROOMS**

Hovet has a number of hospitality rooms suitable for receiving guests of honour, sponsors, press or officials.

- Hovets Hylla has space for 260 seated dinner guests with a dedicated VIP entrance.
- Hovmästarna has space for 150 seated dinner guests with a dedicated VIP entrance.
- Plus three other smaller rooms.

### **HOTEL**

- The Quality Hotel Globe, with 327 guest rooms and 17 conference rooms, is part of the Globen City complex.

### **SHOPPING**

- Globen Shopping, with its 60 stores, is part of the Globen City complex.
